MEDICAID COVERAGE RENEWAL:

Attention Medicaid Recipients:

Due to Covid-19, KanCare was not requiring members to renew their eligibility. Renewals are starting again this year and the families and individuals receiving Medicaid, are required to renew their account information. Renewal notices will go out from the state from March 2023- March 2024

BACK TO SCHOOL ROUTINES
