Documentation for Proof of Income:

Any State assistance or money received for food, rent, etc. is considered income. Bring copies that apply to your household. **VISION cards are not proof**, you MUST show the award letter from the State.

APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED WITHOUT ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION. You will be given your application back and asked to return when you have proper information.
