Library News



This month the library students are focusing on being great digital citizens. One way we can help students achieve this is keeping them safe online. Commonsense.org suggests we discuss ways to keep our children safe online. Here are five tips to help keep kids safe and secure online.

- 1. Talk about the difference between Personal vs private information. Personal might be my favorite color. Private would be their phone number. Never share private information.
- 2.Use privacy settings. Go through the settings on all new apps to make sure you know what information your kids are sharing.
- 3. Avoid location tracking. Location apps are helpful, but apps that use them can find your children and offer them unwanted or inappropriate ads to nearby businesses. Turn them off if you can.
- 4.Make strong Passwords. Use phrases and special characters (at least 8) that make passwords hard to guess but easy to remember. Remind kids to keep passwords private and change them regularly.
- 5. Skip quizzes. Help kids identify and avoid clickbait, quizzes, special offers, and anything that asks for personal or private information. This helps keep information secure and devices safe.

- Do not send your child to school if they are sick. Report your child's absence to the Auburn Elementary office at 785-339-4400 and let your child's teacher know.
- If there is a positive case within your household and the student or staff is NOT fully vaccinated, then they must isolate for 5 days and continue monitoring symptoms for another 5 days. Please contact the school if this applies.
- Please monitor for COVID symptoms and get tested if you are symptomatic.
- Students and Staff must be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication to return to school/work.

Please complete the Online Registration (OLR) for **ALL** of your students on the same application. You will be able to add additional students once you reach the Students tab. If you have any students not returning for the 22-23 school year please fill out the form on http://usd437.net/enrollment.

Returning to District

Definition: Any family that has at least one student who completed the 21-22 school year at a USD 437 school in grades K-11; who is expected to be at a USD 437 school on the first day of the 22-23 school year.

Directions for Online Registration

- 1. Login to your Campus Portal account at http://campus.usd437.net/portal
- 2. Select the More menu
- 3. Click Online Registration
- 4. A new tab/window will open and you will be logged out of Campus Portal.
- 5. For the Annual Registration select Click here to go to Existing Student Registration"
- 6. Verify the students that will be included on your application, the Registration Year, & click "Begin Registration"
- 7. Follow the directions provided on the screen to complete the registration.

New to District

Definition: Any family that did not have at least one student enrolled at a USD 437 school in grades K-11 at the end of the 21-22 school year.

Directions for Online Registration

- 1. Go to the OLR Kiosk screen at http://usd437.net/enrollment
- 2. Select Start New Registration
- 3. Fill in the required information indicated with a red asterisk.
- 4. Check the box for "I'm not a robot."
- 5. Click Begin Registration.
- 6. You will be told your application number. It is recommended you write this number down in case you need to close out of the application and return to it later.
- 7. Follow the directions provided on the screen to complete the registration.

Important Terms

Parent/Guardian: A person who is entrusted by law with the care of a minor. Example: Mom, Dad, Foster Mom, Foster Dad, Educational Advocate, etc.

Emergency Contact: Any person who should be contacted if a parent/guardian cannot be reached.

Other Household Member: Any person who is not a parent/guardian, emergency contact, or student that lives in the same household as the student(s). Example: brother or sister not attending a USD 437 school.

Student: Any person who will be attending a USD 437 school.

Picture Day Info!


Individual student pictures and class group pictures are scheduled for Tuesday, March 29th.
