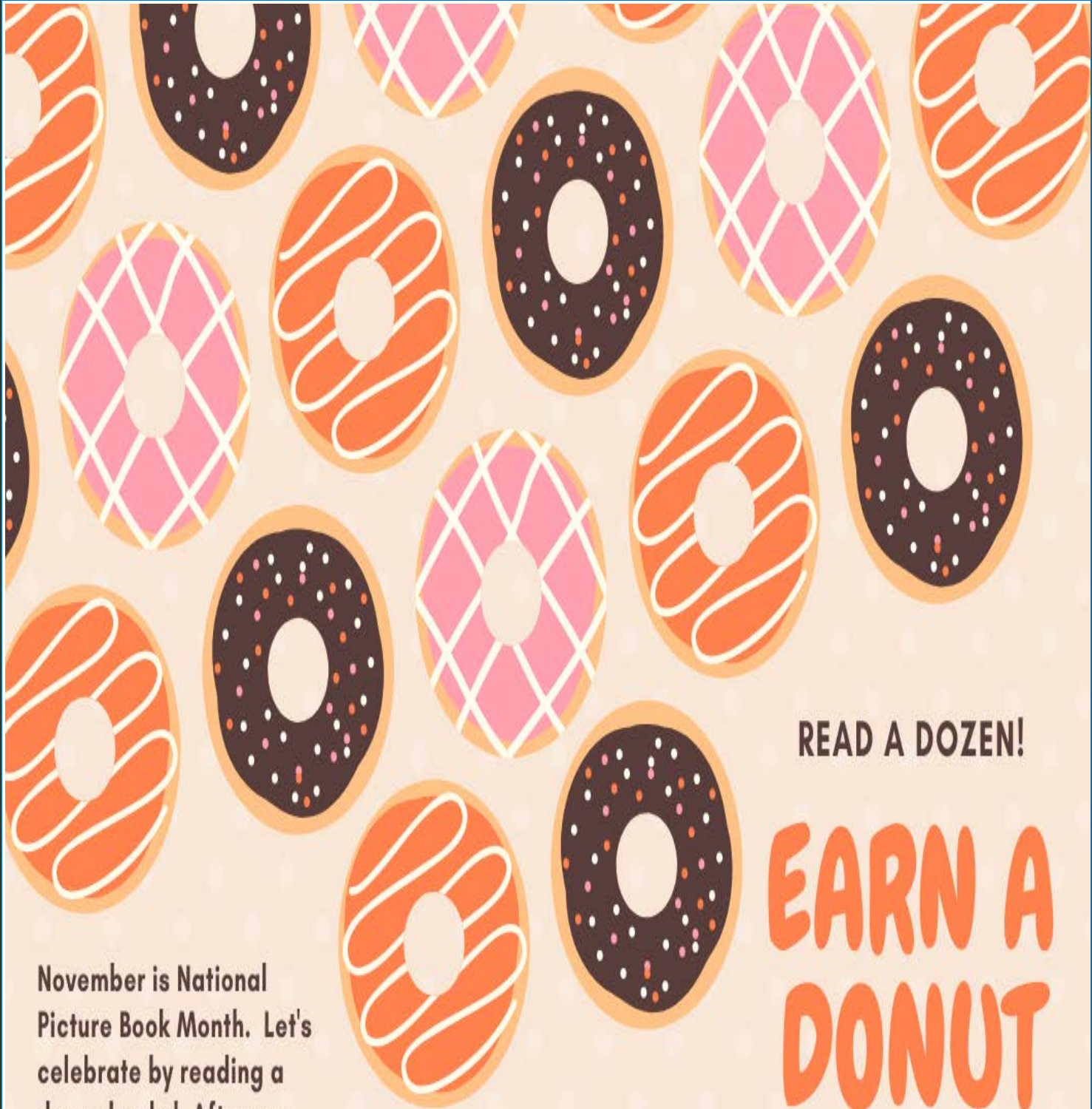
### TRANSPORTATION REMINDERS:
