Dear Auburn Elementary Families,

You will notice a slight change on your child's Grade Card beginning this school year. The Auburn-Washburn School District is transitioning to Standards Based Grading. The beauty of this way of grading is that parents will be able to see exactly how their child is progressing over the course of the school year with individual grade level standards. The Grade Card will be longer as all standards taught and assessed for the whole school year will be contained within the Grade Card. The standards that have a number by them (1, 2, 3, 4) are the standards that are taught and assessed during that particular quarter. of the school year.

Example: 1st Grade Math Standard: "Adds within 10 easily"

Criteria

- 1- Does not demonstrate standard
- 2- With help, demonstrates foundational knowledge of skills
- 3- Independently demonstrates knowledge and skills (at grade level)
- 4- Consistently extends & applies complex knowledge and skills (above grade level)

We Notice Your Pawesome Attendance

School attendance has been a hot topic for the past two years. Since March 2020, school has gone through several phases of in person, on line, and hybrid. It has been difficult to measure students' attendance. Auburn Elementary believes attendance is important for students to be successful in learning and in life.

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Start building this habit early so they learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Eventually good attendance will be a skill that will help them succeed in high school and beyond.

Good attendance has a positive connection with academic skills, social skills, and social emotional learning. Missing as few as two days per month can have a profound negative impact on achievement and a student's self-esteem. Help your student understand the importance of good attendance.

Good attendance is an important part of our ROAR expectations. AE has set our goal for a student absence to be four days or less by semester break. We will not include days required for quarantine. If your student is struggling with wanting to attend school, please contact the teacher, Ms. Boyd or Ms. Gilliland to discuss ways that the school can support your student.

- Skates of any kinds must be inside a bag and only then can they be transported on the bus.


Masks are Required to ride the bus!

Auburn Elementary Pick-up Procedures

Families picking their students up from Auburn Elementary will be following a pick-up lane procedure. We ask that all vehicles enter the car lane at 9th street off Auburn Rd. Please do not block the Auburn City Office or you may get ticketed. From the entrance, you will continue in a single file lane until you reach the school crosswalk, you will then be prompted to loop around the parking lot. This allows for us to get more cars into our lane, but will unfortunately, prohibit families from parking. If you need to park, you will be blocked and will not be able to leave until all cars in the pick-up lane are through. If it is absolutely necessary that you park, you can use the parking lot on the east side of the building. Once families have looped around the parking lot, you will then load student(s) in the "Loading Zone" area. Once students are loaded you will exit out onto 8th street.

It would be helpful if those families/friends picking up students had a sign in their car window with their student's name and grade level.
